



SHERE PARISH COUNCIL

Community Governance Review, Peaslake – Guildford Borough Council reviewed the responses to the Community Governance Review (CRG) for Peaslake to form a separate Parish Council at their meeting on the 29 July 2025. Along with other factors the following decision was made:

“That, taking into account the response received following the consultation in respect of the proposals contained in the community governance petition, no further action be taken in respect of the Community Governance Review and that no changes in community governance arrangements be made in the parish of Shere.”

This means that Peaslake will stay part of Shere Parish Council, alongside Gomshall, Shere, Holmbury St Mary and part of Abinger Hammer (not including the centre).

Chair Penny Tompkins responded the following: *‘the responses to the CRG highlighted that there was work to do to improve relationships between the council and the villages within the parish. This will be an important part of the council’s work going forward to both strengthen the relationships and sustain them.’*

Part Pedestrianisation, The Square, Shere - the huge planters have been removed and replaced with smaller ones. The Surrey County Council (SCC) consultation on the part pedestrianisation closed 28 August 2025 and the responses will be analysed by SCC who will decide whether it will stay in place or not.
